At the February 28, 2009 NYFAB Board of Directors Meeting the Directors voted in favor of **not** hosting any events on Sugar Hill for 2009. HOST SITE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Supply bales made of material that will not damage arrows or allow pass throughs.
- Provide for the pasting of targets.
- Supply cardboard for targets.
- Supply tree markers & directional signs.
- Provide yardage markers for Adult, Youth & Cub distances.
- Provide a five (5) target (minimum) practice range (20 yds. to 60 yds.).
- Provide approximately three (3) workers, including Field Captain, for tournament weekend.
- Provide drinking water & cups on the course.
- Provide concessions.
- Provide sanitary facilities.
- Provide portable toilet(s) on/near course.
- Provide a First Aid kit.
- Provide NYFAB a listing of local hotels & campgrounds.
- Provide NYFAB a listing of local restaurants.
- Carry an up-to-date NFAA Liability Insurance Policy or equivalent.
- Shall not permit the sale of alcoholic beverages during the shooting schedule.

NYFAB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Supply paper targets, with backups, that will be sent to the host site.
- Furnish all awards and scorecards.
- Officiate the event.
- The NYFAB President, 1st VP, 2nd VP & NFAA Director to attend event.
- Supply a Tournament Chairperson and a Registration Chairperson.
- All Fund Raising.
- Provide for event publicity.
- Will inspect the course and facilities at least fifteen (15) days prior to the tournament.
