2014 Hit-Miss Tournament Rules Open to all archers

60 Round consisting of 20 arrows at each yardage, 4 ends of 5 arrows Target Face will be the 40 cm with a 10 cm.

Yellow Center, scoring 1 point Remainder of target is a zero (0)

Touch black line for higher scoring

Pro & Senior & Adult Yardage 40-30-20 yards

Young Adult (15-17) 40-30-20 yards

Youth (12-14) 30-20-10 yards

Cub (0-11) and Traditional 30-20-10 yards

Shooting shortest distance first

Cost \$ 10.00 Seniors & Adults \$ 10.00 YA-Y-C Pro \$ 20.00 includes \$10.00 into pot

In a 6 event season, archers would have to shoot minimum of 2 events to qualify for overall winner. If archer shoots all 6 events, the lowest 4 scores will be dropped.

Awards (medals) at each event

Awards based on flight system with a max of 15 per flight

In the event of ties for 1st place in Championship Flight, shoot will be at the longest distance. In the event of a no show, will take lower place. In the event of ties within a flight, 1st dropped arrow takes lower place.

- Shooters will be called to shooting line by a whistle. Do not approach line prior to whistle.
- ❖ Equipment failure: 15 min. allotted for repairs. An official should be summoned to handle the situation. Missed arrows will be made up at the end of the round. One practice end allowed.
- ❖ All shooters will straddle the shooting line in a reasonably even fashion.
- No smoking is allowed in the shooting area except in designated areas.
- Upon completion of each end, please step away from the shooting line exercising courtesy to the shooters on both sides of you.
- ❖ Any arrow propelled beyond the 10ft. foul line is considered a shot arrow
- ❖ Your target assignment by the registration committee is final. You remain on the same target throughout the entire round.

- ❖ Witnessed bounce outs and pass through in the scoring area can be re-shot. Summon an official to handle the situation. Arrows hanging from the front or rear of the target butt must be handled by a tournament official. Do not touch the arrow.
- No arrow may be touched prior to the completion of scoring all arrows in the butt.
- No alcoholic beverages (or use of nonprescription, mood altering drugs) are allowed while participating in the tournament. Violators will be automatically disqualified.
- Pro Division for all NFAA Pros & NFAA Pros within the year past. We strongly encourage members of other Pro organizations to register in this Pro division. Legitimate credentials required, IBO membership cards, etc.
- Any abusive language will not be tolerated and will result in an automatic disqualification from the tournament.
- ❖ Each group will elect a target captain who will call the scores of all arrows on their target butt. Any discrepancies or questionable arrows must be handled by an official.
- ❖ Each group will decide which two shooters will keep score. Be certain all boxes are filled in on the score card. Alterations on score cards are to be made by drawing a line through the wrong number and entering the correct number alongside.
- ❖ Upon completion of the round, all score cards are to be signed by both scorekeepers along with the shooter, (i.e. three signatures are required on the bottom of the card).
- ❖ Each individual is responsible for turning in both of their score cards, whether complete or not, within 15 minutes of the completion of the round. If no score is turned in, the contestant will be disqualified. In cases of discrepancies between two score cards, the lower score will be used.
- ❖ If an archer shoots more than 5 arrows in an end, only 4 arrows of lowest value will be scored. A penalty of one (1) point will be assessed for each arrow shot over the prescribed number.
- Equipment will be checked at random for compliance within designated style. Anyone found shooting non-compliant equipment will be disqualified.
- ❖ Traditional shooters must shoot off the shelf with traditional arrows
- ❖ Protests are to be submitted to the tournament chairman in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged violation accompanied by a \$10.00 fee, which will be refunded if protest is upheld.
- Any additions to these rules will be determined by the rules committee consisting of: NYFAB President, 1st V.P. and Tournament Chairman.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the shooter to either pickup their award at the site, have someone pickup the award for you or the award will be sent at cost to the archer.
