Privilege of the floor:

Loren Lyndaker spoke on the men's having to go to Lowville after gas that is needed for the trucks. Loren was concerned that it is costly to have the men running back and forth. Loren said that the highway superintendent has the authority to say who comes and goes in the highway department.

Robert Scoville was picked for jury duty and he wants the town board to be aware of the matter.

Charlotte Wheeler was concerned about the well and the lack of water in it as we were approved for a 20-bed shelter.

Action: Norman Roof –contact Rural Development about getting money to help with the well.

Tammy Tanner gave an update on her communication & public relations. She said she gave her input to Norman Roof to put on the Website.

Bruce Snyder talked on the building and grounds committee. He said he checked the oil/water separator that was fitted. He also wants to meet with the highway department and Loren Lyndaker on the grounds and what needs to be done.

Terry Snyder gave a report on FEMA. He reported that FEMA was going to reimburse the town right around \$6500.00 for storm damage. Terry and his men have been fixing roads and hauling stones this month with crushed stones.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Charlotte Wheeler and seconded by Councilmen Bruce Snyder to accept and file the minutes of April 13th, 2004.
